

**MINUTES OF THE
STE. GENEVIEVE BOARD OF ALDERMEN
WORK SESSION
May 27, 2021**

The work session of the Ste. Genevieve Board of Aldermen was called to order at 6:25 p.m. with all members present.

A motion by Alderman Eydmann, second by Alderman Prince to approve the Work Session Agenda as presented. Motion carried 8-0.

City Administrator Welch announced that the first two items on the agenda need to be removed and rescheduled for the next work session as Mr. Hilbert could not make it this evening.

SIDEWALK ASSISTANCE – INCREASE IN FY 2022 BUDGET. Discussion occurred on how to provide financial assistance and/or get homeowners involved in a sidewalk replacement program. It was agreed to put money in the 2022 budget and increase the current reimbursement amount to property owners who replace their sidewalks.

BOB DONOVAN – LEVEE PROPERTY RENT. Alderman Donovan would like to rent the vacant field to the east of the current Jour de Fete Park. It is approximately 3 acres. The property use to be leased by Joe Hecker but has not been leased for a couple years. Mr. Donovan would like the city to waive the rental fee for two years so he has substantial time to remove the johnson grass and weeds and then the rent would be \$150.00 a year. The Board agreed to bring back an ordinance to honor the request.


NEW STREET SPECIFICATIONS. The Board had requested that new street specifications be reviewed and updated by an engineer. Cochran Engineering developed those specifications for contractors and excavators who get street excavation permit. The Board reviewed those specifications and they agreed for these to be brought back for approval by ordinance.

JASON SCHOTT – 15 MINUTE PARKING/COMMON GROUNDS EXTEND TIME. Jason Schott asked if the Board would consider extending the 15 minute parking till 2:00 p.m. since they are serving lunch now. After some discussion it was decided to leave the 15 minute parking as is and not change the time.

ARF-FRF Treasury Rules – Continued Discussion – City Administrator Welch updated the Mayor and Board on the rules.

With no further business the work session was adjourned at 7:10 p.m.
