A motion by Alderman Bennett, second by Alderman Steiger to approve the work session agenda as presented. Motion carried 7-0-1 with Alderwoman Cleghorn absent.

BUSINESS ITEMS.

Police Department Garage Repairs. Jasen Crump, Police Chief discussed improvements that are needed to the police garage that include moisture issues that need to be addressed and fixed. Chief Crump explained that the building has the wrong channel around the bottom of the building therefore it is allowing water to enter the building through the sill plate. This creates a mold issue as well as the metal is beginning to rust. After discussion the Board agreed that Chief Crump should seek bids to get the building repaired properly.

TAP Funding 2024. The Transportation Alternative Program grants (TAP) from MoDOT will be opening early next year and if the Board is interested a few projects need to be prioritized so Cochran can give cost estimates. This would be an 80/20 percent match and if approved construction would more than likely not start until 2028. After discussion the Board chose the sidewalk extension from Gerard Street to Rozier on the east side of Hwy 32 (S. Fourth Street).
